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SEASON DETAILS

Cost of Signing Up is \$50. Included in this price is the player's uniform (jersey, shorts, and socks). This year everyone will get a ball also!

Player's must provide their own shin guards and soccer cleats.

Coaches select teams the week of August 25th

Coaches call players and begin practices the end of August.

First game is scheduled for Saturday, September 20th.

Season lasts through mid November.

Separate boys and girls teams for ages 8-13. Co-ed for ages 4-7.

Typically there are one to three practices a week, with most coaches having two.

Games played on Saturdays and some weekdays depending on age group.

Ball Sizes: Ages 4-7, Size 3; Ages 8-11, Size 4; Ages 12-15, Size 5

Number of players on field: Under 6 3v3 or 4v4, Under 8 5v5, Under 10 7v7, Under 12 9v9, Under 14 and 16 11v11
